RULES AND REGULATION OF KARNATAKA RENEWABLE ENERGY SYSTEM MANUFACTURERS ASSOCIATION

I TITLE

The Rules and Regulation shall be called as rules of the Karnataka Renewable. Energy Systems Manufacturers Association.

II MEMBERSHIP

- Membership of the Association shall be restricted to Karnataka State Renewable.
 Energy equipment manufacturers.
- 2. There shall be following classes of members.

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a. Life Members

Any person qualified for membership may become a life member of the Association on payment of Rs.25000/-.

b. Honorary Members

Any person who has been served/contributed to the development of Renewable Energy sector/industry may be taken as Honorary Member by way of resolution passed in general body meeting of the association.

c. Associate Members

Any person / company who involved in manufacturing of components of Renewable Energy products may be taken as Associate member on payment Rs.5000/- per Annum.

- Application for admission to the life membership and ordinary membership of the Association shall be submitted to the Executive Committee, who shall accept/reject such membership if deemed fit and get approved by the succeeding general Body.
- Application of all the categories of the membership shall be endorsed by any member of the Association.
- 5. The General Body from time to time shall fix such subscription for the different categories of the membership of the Association as the General Body may deem fin and proper. All annual subscription shall be payable along with his/her/their application for membership and such payment shall always be for the entire financial year irrespective of the month and date of admission.

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- 6. a. The membership cease if:
 - (i). Member Resigns on his own.
 - (ii). Member death in the proprietorship concern.
 - (iii). Non Payment of Annual Subscription,
 - (iv). Removed by passing a resolution in General Body Meeting.
 - (v). In the event of company shutdown/closed.
- (vi). Any expelled member can be reinstated by passing a resolution in General Body Meeting.
- 7. Any person ceasing to be a member of the association for any reasons shall nevertheless remain liable to pay all annual subscriptions and other sums payable by him at the date of his ceasing to be a member.
- 8. The association shall need to be kept a Register in which shall be entered:
 - a. Name of the each member
 - b. The Address given in the application and
 - c. The Class of membership in which the enrolment is effected.
- 9. Every member shall forthwith notify to the Secretary any change of address. The address register shall be registered address of the member and shall be the address to which all notices intended for such a members shall be sent unless such notice is published in newspapers in accordance with the provisions of these rules.

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III VOTES OF MEMBERS

- 1, Life Members and ordinary Members present at the meeting shall have only one vote.
- 2. No person other than a member who shall have paid subscription and other sum if any, which shall be due or payable to the Association in respect of his Membership, shall be entitled to be present and vote on any question at any General Body meeting. The Secretary or Treasurer shall inform the defaulting Member about the dues in advance before the commencement of the meeting.

IV EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- 1. The number of members of the Executive Committee shall consist of 7 members including office bearers. The Association may from time to time in General Body meeting increase or reduce the minimum or maximum number of members of the Executive Committee.
- 2. The Executive Committee shall consist of the following office bearers:
 - a. President
 - b. Vice-President
 - c. Secretary
 - d. Treasurer AND
 - c. Three members elected to the Executive Committee.

The immediate past president and past Secretary shall be ex-officio members of the Executive Committee. The office bearers shall be elected by the Association at the Annual General Body Meeting in accordance with provisions of these rules.

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The term of the office for the members of the Executive Committee including office bearer is three years and they are eligible for re-election.

V TERMS OF OFFICE OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

A retiring member of the executive committee shall retain his office until the end of the meeting at which he retires from office.

VI DISQUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

- A member of the Executive Committee including the office bearers shall ipsofacto cease to be a committee member if he/she.
- 2 Fails to attend three consecutive meetings of the Executive Committee without leave of absence.
- 3 Who is removed from office by a vote of no-confidence passed at the General Body meeting of the members of the association by not less than two-third of the members present.
 - 4. Is adjudged insolvent.
 - 5. Is found to be of unsound mind by a court of competent jurisdiction, or
 - 6. Ceases to be a member of the association
 - 7. Submits his/her resignation in writing and such resignation is accepted or
 - 8. Dies.

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VII MEETING EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

- 1. The Executive Committee shall meet not less than once in a month. The place and date of the meeting shall be decided by the Secretary in consultation with the President unless a meeting of the Executive Committee decides otherwise. Advance notice of at least 7 days shall be served to the executive Committee members.
- 2. Any three members of the Executive Committee may submit a requisition in writing served by Registered post asking the Hon. Secretary and President to convene a meeting of the Committee and the Hon. Secretary or President shall convene a meeting within 7 days of the receipt of such requisition by giving 21 clear day's Registered Notice, and if the Hon. Secretary or President fails to convene a meeting within prescribed time, the signatories of the requisition shall have the power to convene a meeting of Executive Committee by giving 14 clear day's registered notice in writing. The quorum for such meeting shall be the same as that prescribed in these rules.

VIII PROCEEDINGS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

1. The Executive Committee, may meet for the discu of business, adjourn or otherwise regulate its meeting as it thinks fit. Unless otherwise determined, 3 members shall form a quorum. If such a quorum is not present the President shall adjourn the meeting for half an hour and conduct the proceedings with the members present which will form the quorum for that meeting. Questions arising at any meeting shall be decided by a majority of votes. In case of any equality of votes, the president shall have a second or casting vote.

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- 2. On the request of President or any two Honorary office bearer's r any three members of the Executive Committee, the Secretary shall at any time sum meeting of the Executive Committee by Registered Notice served upon the members of the Executive Committee. A member of the Executive Committee who is absent from India shall not be entitled to receive a notice of a meeting.
- 3. At least 15 days Registered Notice shall be given to every member of the Executive Committee but an emergency or urgent meeting may be held at 3 days notice by a Mail, telephone or Fax at such place and time as may be determined by the President.
- The President or one of the office bearers or in their absence a member of the Executive Committee if so chosen by the Members present shall preside as Chairman.
- 5. The Executive Committee shall cause proper minutes to be made of all appointments of office made by the Executive Committee and of the proceedings of all meetings of the association and of the Executive Committee and of all business transacted at such meetings and any such minutes of any meeting if purporting to be signed by the Chairman of any such meeting, or by the Chairman of the next succeeding meeting shall be sufficient evidence without any further proof, of the fact therein stated.

IX GENERAL BODY MEETING:

1. The Association shall hold a General Body Meeting in every Calendar year as its annual meeting at such time and place as may be determined by the Executive committee and shall specify the meeting as such in the notice calling it, provided that every general body meeting shall be held not more than fifteen months after the holding of the last preceding meeting.

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- 2. An extra ordinary meeting shall be summoned by the President or Executive Committee on the requisition of 1/10th of the Members of the Association for the time being or if the President thinks it necessary to do so. It shall be the duty of the President or the Honorable Secretary to call such meeting within one month of the receipt of the requisition as aforesaid.
- 3. In case of both the annual general meeting and any extra-ordinary general meeting, at least 21 day's notice of the meeting shall be given. The notice shall specify the date, hour and place of the meeting and as far as possible a statement of business proposed to be transacted. The omission to give or any mistake in giving notice of any general meeting shall not invalidate the proceeding of such meeting. The annual general body meeting shall be summoned either by the President or the hon. Secretary.
- 4. The functions of the Annual General Body Meeting are:
- a) To receive from the Executive Committee, the audited Balance Sheet and report made up for each year (together with the Income and Expenditure Account) of the Association , provided that the first Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Account shall be made up from the date of the commencement to the 31st day of December.
- b) To elect members of the Executive committee from amongst the association 's members.
- c) To appoint Chartered Accountants to audit the accounts of the association during the year and to fix their remuneration.
- d) To consider any other business brought forward by or with the consent of the President.

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No business shall be transacted at any General Meeting or extra-ordinary, unless quorum is present when the meeting proceeds to business. Save as herein otherwise provided, one third of the members of the association shall be the quorum. If within half an hour where after if a quorum is not present, the Members present shall themselves from quorum.

X POWERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

A. The association shall be governed by and be under the overall supervision of the executive committee with regard to matters of policy. The Executive Committee may exercise all such powers of the association and do on behalf of the association all such acts and things as may be exercised or done at the Annual General Meeting. Subject, as aforesaid the Executive Committee may also delegate any or all the powers and authorities vested in it to any committee or sub-committee.

B. The Members for the time being of the Executive Committee may act notwithstanding any vacancy in their body, provided always that in case the Members of the Executive committee shall at any time be or reduced in number to less than the minimum number prescribed by or in accordance with these presents, it shall be lawful for them to act as the Executive committee for the purpose of co-opting member in the vacancies caused or of summoning a general body meeting, but not for any other purpose.

C. Any casual vacancy occurring in the Executive Committee may be filled up by the rest of its members, but the person so chosen shall be subject to retirement at the same time as if he had become a member of the Executive Committee in whose place he is appointed was last elected to the post.

XI FUNDS:

- . a. The funds of the association inter alia, shall consist of:
 - (i) Revenue from subscriptions or membership fees.
- (ii) Donations and contributions.
- (iii) Proceeds of any publications issued or sponsored by the association including advertisement revenue or other material:
 - (iv) Fees for any classes or courses conducted by the Association.
- (v) Grants from any conventions, film shows and other activities of the association in accordance with its objectives.
 - (vi) Grants from any Government or any private trust and Organizations.
- b. The Executive Committee shall open an account of the association with any scheduled bank, the cheques drawn on the bank shall be signed by two authorized signatories, one of which the shall be treasurer and other one from the President or Secretary.
- The funds of the association shall be utilized for the general aims and objectives mentioned in the Memorandum of the association.
- 3. The income and property of the association whenever/whomsoever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the association and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend or otherwise howsoever or by way of profits of the members of the association provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment of remuncration to any service/officers or employees of the association or to any members of the association or other person in return for any services actually rendered to the association or by way of reimbursement of payment made or costs, charges of expenses incurred in or about the objects or affairs of or on behalf of the association

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- but so that (save as aforesaid) no remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given to any officer, employee or member of the association.
 - 4. The net surplus of incurring the expenditure of the association shall only be utilized towards the objects of the association and shall at no time be distributed to the members of the association.

XII ACCOUNTS:

The Executive Committee shall cause true accounts to be kept of all sums of money received and expended by the association and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure took place and the assets credits and liabilities of the association Books of account shall be kept at the office of the association books of account shall be kept at the office of the association or at such place or places in charge of such person or persons at the association may from time to time.

XIII AUDIT:

- The Accounts of the association shall be submitted after the end of every financial year which has to be audited by a duly qualified auditor or auditors who shall be appointed at each Annual General Body Meeting.
- 2. The auditors shall make a report to the members of the association of the accounts examined by them and on every Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Accounts laid before the Annual General Meeting of the association during their career of office and the report shall state inter-alia.

XIV FINANCIAL YEAR:

Financial year of the association shall be from 1st April to 31st March of every year.

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XVII ANNUAL REPORTS:

1. a. The Executive Committee shall submit to the Annual General body Meeting a report of the work done by the Association together with a statement of accounts showing all money received and expended during the previous financial year and Balance Sheet containing a summary of the assets and liabilities of the association made up to the last day of the Financial year.

The association shall file the Annual Reports with the concerned statutory authority.

XVII MINUTES:

Minutes of all proceedings of General Body Meeting, Executive Committee and all sub-committee of the association shall be entered or caused to be entered regularly by the Honorary Secretary in appropriate minute book kept by him. Any such minutes of any proceedings so entered in the appropriate minute book if properly signed by the Chairman of the Meeting concerned or by the Chairman of succeeding meeting shall be receivable as primafacie evidence of the matters stated in such minutes. All minute's book of the association shall be open for inspection to any member of the association at any reasonable time at the office of the association.

XVIII INDEMNITY:

Every member of the Executive committee, the Secretary and other officer or servants of the association shall be indemnified by the association and it shall be the duty of the executive committee of the association to pay all costs, losses and expenses which any such member of the Executive Committee, Secretary or other officer or servant may incur or may become liable by reason of any contract entered into or acts or things done by him as officer or servant or in any way in the discharge of his duties. R. 2. 72. Page 17 of 18

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XIX NEW RULES AND ALTERATIONS OF RULES:

The general body shall be entitled to add, alter or amend these Rules, The Rules herein contained or hereafter to be made shall be amended altered or rescinded except with the consent of a majority of two thirds of the number of the members of the General body called for the purpose. Such alterations as per the provisions of the Karnataka Societies Registration act.

XX WINDING UP:

The association shall not be wound up except by a special resolution to be passed by a majority of not less than three-fourth of the votes of the members personally present at a special general meeting of the association of which 21 clear days notice shall have been given setting out full particulars of the resolution proposed and the reasons thereof.

If upon dissolution of the association, there shall remain after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed amongst the members of the association nor any of them but shall be given to some other Association or in situation having objects similar to the objects of the association as determined by the members of the association at the time of dissolution. If however the association shall transfer its property or hand it over to any person or institution for the purposes of any of the objects for which the association has been formed. Amalgamations and dissolutions, if it has ansed the provisions of K.S.R. Act., shall be followed.

XXI APPLICABILITY OF KARNATAKA SOCIETIES REGISTRATION ACT AND RULES:

Unless otherwise provided in these rules, the provisions of the Karnataka Societies Registration Act and Rules shall apply.

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
